- Cumulative Grade Point Average 2.0 or better (verified by homeroom teacher);
- Step Sheet Average of 2 or above (verified by Homeroom Teacher);
- Completed Recommendation Form from two current teachers (one core and one encore).

Fine Arts Submission— (up to 3 scholarships will be awarded)

Musical Instrument or Vocal Solo -

- Staple your required eligibility documents to your completed application;
- Submit video/audio tape of performance;
- Submit one page narrative describing your selection choice*

Art work -

- Staple your required eligibility documents to your completed application;
- Staple a 3 X 5 card with your name and homeroom to <u>back of art work</u>;
- Submit one page narrative describing details of your artwork;*
- Packet should be reviewed and signed by the art teacher prior to submission;
- Place in 11X18 envelope available from the Coolidge Office.

Academic Submission - (up to 2 scholarships awarded)

- One page typed essay *
- Single spaced
- 250 word maximum
- Prompt to be determined
